

PHLEBOTOMY CLASS INFORMATION SHEET

A phlebotomist is a medical technician who draws blood for analysis.

Requirements:

- Copy of High School Diploma or GED & copy of Photo I.D.
- \$30 non-refundable Entrance Exam fee
- Entrance Exam – TABE Test (Reading and Math)
- Agreement to submit to a drug screen and criminal background check before clinical experience.
- **\$200 seat deposit must be paid no later than December 21, 2018**
